



Night Sky Highlights

November 1 - Daylight Savings time ends at 2am. - November 3 - Last Quarter Moon.

November 11 - New Moon.

November 17 - Leonid Meteor Shower peaks. Best viewing hours before dawn. Moon free sky!!!

November 19 - First Quarter Moon.

November 25 - Full Moon. According to folklore it is the Full Beaver Moon.

Brightest Stars: West: Vega, Deneb, Altair South: Formalhaut North East: Capella East: Aldebaran

Binocular Highlights: The Moon, Milky Way from Cassiopeia through the Summer Triangle, Andromeda Galaxy M31, Double Cluster (NGC 869&884), Pleiades.

Telescope Highlights: The Moon, Uranus, Neptune, Albireo, M31, M39, M1, M2, M27, M57, M15, M11, M81, M82, M 36, 37, 38 (near Capella), NGC869 & 864.
